Staying at the Hotel Rauthhof, a Austrian three star, for the eighteenth time.



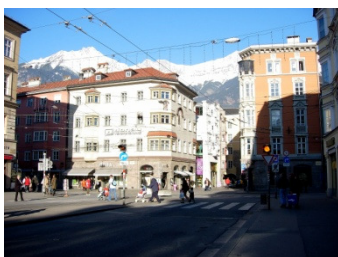

Skiing

- 3 days Stubai glacier (Stubai valley)
- 1 day Pitztal glacier (Mittleburg valley)
- 1 day Hintertux glacier (Ziller valley)



Beginners

There are a lot of good skiing opportunities on the glaciers for beginners and most instructors speak good English. There are wide gentle pistes and easy drag lifts for your first days on skis. As you improve there are a variety of pistes, of varying difficulties, for you to try.

Intermediates

The choice of blue and red runs is limitless within the scope of the average holiday. As our coach will be going to 3 different glaciers over the week this is a great opportunity to improve and put "miles under your skis"

Advanced

The vast scale of the glaciers in the Austrian Tirol means that most advanced skiers will find plenty to do and enjoy.

All the pistes are well prepared and are well marked.

Non-skiing activities

There are many non-skiing activities for people who don't wish to ski e.g. walking, mountain biking, bike touring and many tourist attractions including the alpine zoo and Bergisel Park with the famous ski jump which operates all year round.

The walking routes in the Austrian Tirol region are some of the best in Europe, with walks for all abilities. Mountain bikes can also be hired locally to the hotel with trails up and down the valley.

The recent redevelopment of the Hungerburg cable car gives the none skier the chance to go from Innsbruck city centre to the top of the Hafeleker 2256m in 30 minutes on the new cable car & funicular system giving stunning views across the Inn valley.

There are many other places to visit such as Salzburg, Kitzbuhel and Mayrhofen. All are accessible by the excellent public transport network across Austria. There is also the steam railway from Mayrhofen which runs twice daily and connects to the main railway at Jenbach and also the world famous Swarovski crystal factory at Wattens.

Weather conditions

In the valley the weather conditions can be very warm, but on the mountains conditions, although mostly sunny, are considerably colder. We MUST advise that a high factor sun cream and lip salve such as Factor 25 or 50 is worn. You will be skiing at a high altitude (10,000 feet or above) and therefore the ultraviolet rays are much stronger. We also advise that good quality goggles or glasses are worn.

Lift passes

Bought on a daily basis, approx £30 per day. Any reductions from purchasing as a coach party are given refunded to customers.



Ski hire

Skis, poles and boots hired from CT Ski £31, skis only are £23.50, Boots only £11.50, Junior skis, poles and boots £19 (130cm and under), and snowboard and boots are £36, The prices above include carver and our top end skis.
